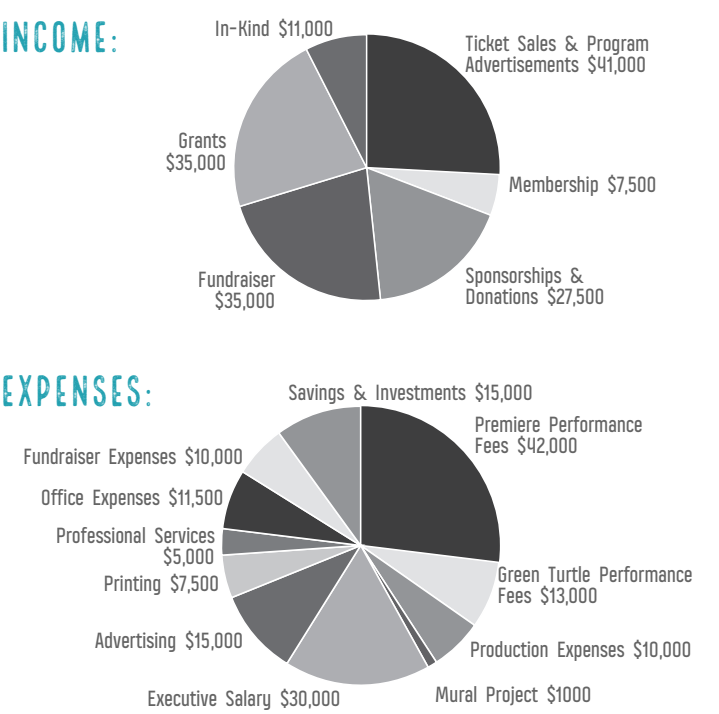

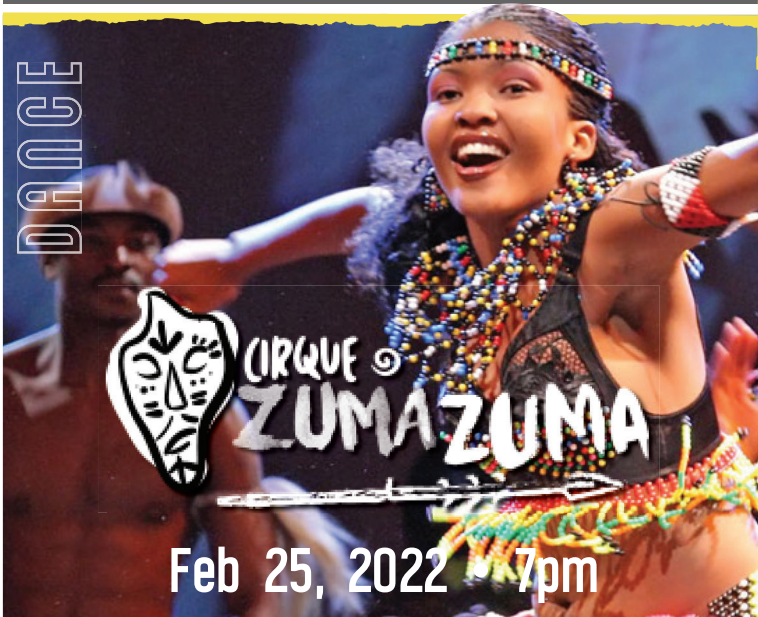


CROCE PLAYS CROCE
